- 1. Minutes of November 29, 2017 meeting approved. No changes or additions.

The WMCA now has 89 house-holds as members, with a total membership as of Jan 24, of 161, or double last year at this time.

Two note-worthy expenses for Dec. Keiser Bros. Printing/mailing --- \$955.... a very good price for all their effort and expertise. and, \$49 to Bob Wehr for the mailing of notice for the Civil War program.

WMCA Bank balance as of Jan 24. 2018 ---- \$2,469..... solidly in positive territory !!!

The raffles seem to work well at the dinners at Homewood -- Bob is able to get dining gift cards of \$50, for only \$40 at Costco, nice savings and we always come out ahead with this idea.
