Our program for January 18,2024 has been confirmed. Jessica Fitzwater, our Country Executive will be giving a virtual presentation of the State of the County. Diane Derr contacted her office for confirmation. Diane will not be available to introduce the speaker, so someone else will have to.

Diane took a class, Wills 101 at FCC. She suggested that it would be a good program for some future time.

Lisa suggested a talk on the Frederick Co Transit system. Buses are Free.

Diane also suggested that we purchase a "clip on" mic for future live presentations. It would make PowerPoint presentations easier for the speaker, and our handheld mic could be used for questions from the audience.
