

CIVIL WAR CONFEDERATES IN FREDERICK /PHOTO MYSTERY

For more than 150 years historians and Civil War experts have debated the facts surrounding a famous photo of Confederate troops marching in the streets of downtown Frederick during the Civil War. Our guest speakers Erik Davis and Paul Bolcik have uncovered the truth, date, and exact location behind a famous photo of Confederate troops taken in Frederick, MD in 1864.

They presented their methods and fact-finding study in an excellent power-point presentation focusing on the famous Confederate photo, and how Worman's Mill played a key role in debunking the year and location in which the troops marched through downtown Frederick. Their study also includes fascinating details on how they were able to create a "then and now" representation of the photo and how they dealt with interesting challenges to create a realistic, computerized 3D model of street .
